Multi-Disciplinary Team (MDT)

The Champaign County Multidisciplinary Team (MDT) consists of the Champaign County State's Attorney's Office, 26 local law enforcement agencies, the Department of Children and Family Services (DCFS), CAC staff, local mental health providers, and medical personnel.

- Unique # of DCFS Families served: 50
- Unique # of law enforcement-only families served: 21
- Formal Case Review meetings with the MDT: 12
- Non-offending caregivers served: 117
- The MDT conducted pre and post interview meetings for 100% of the interviews
- CAC staff conducted mandated reporter training at 6 schools and a local park district
- DCFS attended 100% of DCFS-related interviews
- Law Enforcement attended 100% of law enforcement involved interviews
- 3 MDT members attended the 2019 Champions for Children Conference
- 4 MDT members attended the Child First forensic interviewer training
- 32 MDT members attended Multi-disciplinary Team: Building Resiliency in MDTs training
- The CAC displayed 31 blue kids through Champaign County for Child Abuse Prevention Month








Fiscal Year 2019 Finances
