


#### CHAMPAIGN COUNTY MULTIDISCIPLINARY TEAM (MDT):

The MDT consists of the Ford and Champaign County States Attorney's Office, CAC staff, DCFS investigators, 15 law enforcement agencies, (including the FBI and homeland security), CARLE (medical), and 4 local mental health professionals.

- 5 MDT members attended the annual Children's Advocacy Center of Illinois Champions of Children Conference.
- MDT Case Review was conducted 12 times virtually with all MDT disciplines.
- CAC forensic interviewers were trained by the FBI in presenting evidence.
- 6 MDT members attended the "Carle Hospital Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner annual conference" where the CAC MDT Coordinator presented.
- CAC forensic interviewer conducted mandated reporter training to 4 community agencies.
- All CAC staff attended the Youth Sexual Exploitation & Human Trafficking training.
