


## **Victim's Demographics**

Victim's Race/Ethnicity










## **Perpetrator's Demographics**

## Champaign County Multidisciplinary Team (MDT):

- 8 MDT members attended the First Annual Buetow Child Abuse Symposium
- 9 MDT members attended the 2023 Champions of Children conference hosted by Children's Advoacy Center of Illinois
- 2 new law enforcement MDT members became trained in the Child First forensic interview protocol.
- Ford County established a SART (Sexual Assault Response Team) and CAC staff are members of this new initiative.
- CAC staff presented to 4 community organizations and completed 6 interviews with local news stations and the local newspaper.





**Counseling Services:** The CAC provided 656 hours of counseling. 78% of the children and non-offending caregivers who were referred to counseling attended counseling.

**Survey Results:** The CAC offers satisfaction surveys to non-offending caregivers, children over the age of 10, and MDT partners.
