**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2012-6** 

Effective immediately, all body attachments issued in the wake of the failure of the

respondent to appear on a claim of indirect civil contempt of court are subject to the following

provisions:

1) All body attachments henceforth issued for failure to appear on a

claim of indirect civil contempt of court shall have an effective duration of

one year from the date of issuance;

2) All such body attachments shall bear an explicit and conspicuous

recital that such writ is not to be executed beyond one year from the date

of its issuance; and

3) All such body attachments issued on or before October 10, 2011 are

hereby quashed.

This Administrative Order supplements Administrative Order 2012-5, implementing Public

Act 97-848, by placing temporal limits on body attachments issued in indirect civil contempt of

court proceedings irrespective of the nature or classification of the case in which the civil

contempt claim arises.
