**BOARD OF REVIEW EXAM**

The Department of Revenue, Springfield, Illinois, has fixed **Thursday, April 27, 2017**, as the date for an examination for the position of Board of Review member, pursuant to 35 ILCS 200/6-10 of the Property Tax Code.

The examination will be held at the Brookens Administrative Center, in the Lyle Shields meeting room located at 1776 E. Washington St., Urbana, IL. at 10:00 a.m. The examination and facilities will be accessible to persons with disabilities in compliance with state and federal laws. Persons in need of special accommodations should notify Kay Rhodes at 217-384-3776 by April 25, 2017 at 10:00 a.m. to make the necessary arrangements.

The Champaign County Board will act upon the County Board Chair's appointment in May 2017.

**Qualifications for appointment to Champaign County Board of Review:**

1. No person may serve on the Board of Review who is not qualified by virtue of experience and training in the field of property appraisal and property tax administration.
2. No person may serve on the Board of Review who has not passed an examination prepared and administered by the Department of Revenue to determine his or her competence to hold such office.
3. The Board of Review shall at all times consist of two members with the political party polling the highest vote for any County office in the County, and one member of the party polling the second highest vote for the same County office in the County at the last general election in the County prior to the time any appointment is made.

**SPECIAL PROVISIONS**

In counties under township organization containing less than 1,000,000 inhabitants, members of the County Board may, but are not required to, be appointed to the Board of Review.
