

WORKPLACE INJURY

The County will provide medical attention to any employee who experiences a work-related injury or illness and will make every attempt to accommodate employees who cannot perform their regular job because of temporary medical restrictions.

- **WHAT SHOULD I DO IF I AM INJURED ON THE JOB?**
 - If the injury is non-life threatening, immediately report it to your Department Head/Supervisor (not a co-worker)
 - Seek Medical Attention
 - Fill out County Injury Reports
 - Submit all Medical paperwork to Department Head/Supervisor
 - Ask Questions
