**COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2015-02**

**Electronic Home Detention Protocol**

No defendant will be permitted to serve any portion of a county jail sentence on electronic home detention (hereinafter "EHD") without the prior written approval of the Champaign County Sheriff or his designee. The requirement for written approval applies to all defendants regardless of whether EHD compliance is to be monitored by the Champaign County Sheriff or the sheriff of any other county.


After evaluation of a defendant's suitability for the EHD program, the Champaign County Sheriff is ordered to file a certificate notifying the court of the her/his decision to approve or deny the defendant's request. The Champaign County Sheriff will file certificates of approval or denial with the Champaign County Circuit Clerk. A courtesy copy of each certificate will be provided to the Court by delivering a copy to the court security officer designated for that courtroom.

If a defendant is approved for out-of-county EHD by the Champaign County Sheriff, the sheriff of another county, and the Court, defense counsel is required to file with the Court written confirmation of the defendant's compliance with out-of-county EHD. The trial judge will determine the date/time for the defendant to surrender for out-of-county EHD and the timeframe for written confirmation of compliance by defense counsel.

This Order is effective immediately.
