<p>Case Synopsis: On Saturday (07/20/24) at approximately 1804 hrs, a Champaign County Deputy Sheriff attempted to conduct a routine traffic stop in the village of Philo, after observing a vehicle that did not have a rear license plate displayed. The involved vehicle was a blue and white sport bike/motorcycle, that had been operated by an adult male driver. That vehicle was followed by the deputy, as it made several abrupt turns and disobeyed several stop signs. This traffic stop was conducted with emergency lights and sirens activated. However, the male driver accelerated at a high rate of speed through town and essentially fled from the traffic stop. The vehicle reached speeds in upwards of 100 mph. The suspect driver was identified by the deputy from past in-person contacts. The suspect has not been located as of this report.</p>
